## PART 3 | PERFECT PRIESTHOOD

Day 1: The Power of Jesus' Presence

Daily Reading: Matthew 9:20-22

#### Devotional

The story of the woman with the issue of blood reminds us of the immense power in Jesus' presence. Just as she was healed by touching the hem of His garment, we too can experience transformation through faith in Christ. Reflect on areas in your life where you need Jesus' healing touch. How can you reach out to Him in faith today?

#### **Application**

Remember, His power is just as present and available to us now as it was then. Take a moment to "touch the hem of His garment" through prayer, asking for His presence to permeate your life.

Day 2: Jesus as Our High Priest

Daily Reading: Hebrews 4:14-16

#### Devotional

Jesus, our great High Priest, bridges the gap between humanity and God. Unlike earthly priests, He perfectly understands our struggles because He lived as one of us. Yet, He remained sinless. This unique position allows Him to both empathize with our weaknesses and offer perfect intercession on our behalf. How does knowing Jesus intimately understands your struggles change your approach to prayer?

#### **Application**

Take time to boldly approach God's throne today, sharing your deepest needs and concerns, knowing Jesus is there advocating for you.

**Day 3: The Transformative Power of Christ** 

Daily Reading: 2 Corinthians 5:17

**Devotional** 

The sermon speaker shared his personal transformation from a troubled past to becoming a pastor. This echoes the promise that in Christ, we are new creations. Salvation isn't just about future eternity; it's about present transformation. Reflect on how encountering Jesus has changed you.

#### **Application**

What old patterns or identities has He helped you shed? What new aspects of your identity in Christ are you still growing into? Pray for continued transformation, asking God to reveal areas where He wants to make you new today.

**Day 4: Sharing Our Testimony** 

Daily Reading: Revelation 12:11

#### Devotional

We're reminded that we overcome "by the blood of the Lamb and the word of our testimony." Our stories of God's work in our lives are powerful tools for encouragement and evangelism. Take some time to write down key moments in your faith journey. How has God shown up in your life? What miracles, big or small, have you witnessed?

#### **Application**

Consider sharing one of these testimonies with someone today, whether a fellow believer who needs encouragement or someone who doesn't yet know Christ.

Day 5: Jesus: More Than We Can Comprehend

Daily Reading: Colossians 1:15-20

#### **Devotional**

The sermon emphasized that Jesus is more than any single title or role can encompass. He is simultaneously prophet, priest, king, friend, healer, and so much more. This passage in Colossians gives us a glimpse of Christ's supremacy and all-encompassing nature. As you read, let the magnitude of who Jesus is wash over you. Where in your life have you perhaps limited your view of Christ?

#### **Application**

Ask the Holy Spirit to expand your understanding and experience of Jesus in all His fullness. Close by worshipping Him for who He is – the one "in whom all things hold together."
