Opening Question

What comes to mind when you hear the word "prophet"? How has your understanding of prophecy been shaped by modern culture or past experiences?

- 4.) How does understanding Jesus as a prophet change or enhance your view of Him?
- 5.) The sermon touched on the topic of modern-day prophets. How can we discern between true and false prophets in today's world?
- 6.) Reflect on Acts 1:7-8 and the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. How do you see the Holy Spirit working in your life and in the church today?
