Discussion Questions

- 1.) What stood out to you most from the sermon? Why?
- 2.) Pastor Zach mentioned that "if you've heard the Word of God and you've left unchanged, you may know of Him, but I am certain you do not know Him." How has your knowledge of God changed you personally?
- 3.) How do you currently pursue knowing God more deeply? What new practices could you incorporate to deepen your relationship with Him?
- 4.) The sermon emphasized the importance of being known by God rather than seeking worldly recognition. In what areas of your life do you struggle with prioritizing God's opinion over others'?
- 5.) Reflect on Psalm 139:23-24: "Search me, God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts." How comfortable are you with inviting God to search your heart? What might be holding you back?
- 6.) Pastor Zach mentioned that the church will be diving deeper into less commonly preached books of the Bible. Which books are you most curious about exploring, and why?
- 7.) How can we as individuals and as a group better "shine the light of Jesus into a dark and hurting world"? What practical steps can we take?



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Practical Application

- 1.) Daily Scripture Reading: Commit to reading a chapter of the Bible each day this week, focusing on really understanding and applying it to your life.
- 2.) Prayer Journal: Start a prayer journal where you invite God to search your heart. Write down what He reveals to you and how you plan to respond.
- 3.) Intentional Conversations: Challenge yourself to have at least one conversation this week where you intentionally share something about your faith or God's impact on your life.
- 4.) Group Outreach: Plan a group activity that allows you to serve the community and share God's love in a tangible way.
- 5.) Accountability Partners: Pair up with someone in the group to check in regularly on your spiritual growth and how you're applying the "Becoming Well-Known" vision in your daily life.
