DISCUSSION QUESTIONS | PART 4

1. Reflecting on the transformative impact of community involvement, how can you actively contribute to the spiritual growth of your church or faith group? (Hebrews 10:24-25)
2. In what ways have you experienced the transformative power of prayer in your life? Share an instance where a heartfelt prayer led to unexpected growth or change. (James 5:16)
3. How can we recognize when we are becoming spiritually disoriented, and what steps can we take to seek divine guidance to realign ourselves with God's path? (Proverbs 3:5-6)
4. Discuss the Prayer of Jabez (1 Chronicles 4:10). What can we learn from Jabez's plea for blessings and protection, and how can we apply these principles to our daily lives?
5. The sermon talks about the paradox of finding victory in surrender. How does this concept challenge the way you live your life, and what scripture speaks to you about the power of surrender? (Matthew 16:25)
6. Reflect on a time when you embraced a selfless path. How did this choice align with the teachings of Jesus, and what was the outcome? (Philippians 2:3-4)
7. Share a personal insight or story about a time when prioritizing your relationship with God led to extraordinary movement in your life. (Matthew 6:33)
8. In the sermon, the importance of avoiding complacency in our spiritual journey is highlighted. How can we ensure that our faith continues to transform us and doesn't become stagnant? (Romans 12:2)
9. Discuss the role of a supportive community in protecting us from spiritual pitfalls. How can you both contribute to and benefit from such a support system? (Ecclesiastes 4:9-10)
10. The sermon encourages us to consider what we are growing through our prayers. What are some specific seeds you are planting in your prayer life, and how are you nurturing them to bear fruit? (Galatians 6:7-9)
