Discussion Questions

- 1. Reflect on the role of community service in spiritual growth. How does serving others align with God's plan for us, and what impact does it have on both the giver and receiver? (Matthew 25:35-40)
- 2. Discuss the power of prayer in nurturing and growing a church community. How does prayer act as the foundation for a congregation's vitality? (James 5:16)
- 3. The sermon highlights the Prayer of Jabez and its focus on blessings and expanded territories. How can we apply the principles of Jabez's prayer in our personal lives and our communities? (1 Chronicles 4:9-10)
- 4. How do the teachings of Jesus Christ serve as the cornerstone of faith and church life? In what ways can we recognize and build upon this foundation? (Matthew 16:18)
- 5. Share personal experiences where you have seen God's hand at work in your life. How does acknowledging God's presence in our daily lives change our perspective on challenges and opportunities? (Isaiah 41:10)
- 6. King David's life was filled with both triumphs and failures. How does his journey encourage us to seek spiritual renewal and maintain hope in God's redemptive power? (Psalm 51:10-12)
- 7. Discuss the importance of dreaming big and praying with boldness. How can we trust in God's guidance even when we feel unqualified or overwhelmed? (Ephesians 3:20-21)
- 8. Consider the simple acts of kindness described in the Sermon. How can such actions spread hope and uplift spirits within the community? (Galatians 6:9-10)
- 9. How does embracing the challenges of greater responsibilities and service align with living out our faith? Share thoughts on seeking comfort versus embracing God's calling for us. (Luke 9:23-24)
- 10. The Sermon speaks to the notion that imperfection does not disqualify us from God's work. How can we find encouragement in knowing that God uses flawed individuals for His purposes? (2 Corinthians 12:9)
